- ensure that my child attends school regularly, promptly and properly equipped
- make every effort to support your child's learning at home

- avoid taking your child on holiday in term time
- where possible, make the most of both informal and formal visits to the school to show a positive interest in the progress of your child
- work with the school to ensure my child behaves well
- make sure that your child is ready to start school at 9.00am.
- come in to school to discuss concerns, not write grievances on social media sites.
