### Pupil Premium Application Reminder

We would like to remind parents of the Pupil Premium Grant – this is money funded from the government for families who are or have been in receipt of free school meals (not the universal free school meals Reception to Year 2). The money comes into school and can be used to help pupils with additional support in accessing the curriculum and with the various costs that can arise during the school year. There is also additional grant money available for children from Forces Families or children who have been adopted or have left care. Please let Miss Guy in the School Office know if your child is eligible.
