English

Non-fiction writing- Information texts

The children will learn the difference between fiction and non fiction. They will **explore** the different features of an information text. They will read a range of non fiction texts to understand how they are laid out. All of this will then be used for the children to write their own information page about dinosaurs.

Poetry - The children will read, perform and write poetry using their senses.





Maths

Year 1.

<u>Addition and subtraction</u>- The children will be finishing their addition and subtraction unit by learning to subtract using different resources and pictures. They will begin to find the difference between numbers and sums, and compare these. <u>Shape</u>

The pupils will be recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes and looking at patterns. They will end the term by learning about tens and ones and becoming more confident with numbers to 20.

Year 2

<u>Addition and subtraction</u>- The children will be finishing their addition and subtraction unit by applying the learnt methods to solve word problems.

<u>Shape</u>

The pupils will name, sort and describe 2D and 3D shapes by their properties, including lines of symmetry.

Creative Development.

Art/DT- The artists will create dinosaur skeletons and build their own dinosaur. They will use a range of techniques and materials to achieve this.

Music - Bringing us together

The musicians will listen, appraise and contribute to class performances.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

RE – Why does Christmas matter?

The children will explore why Christmas is important to Christians. They will retell the Christmas story and identify what they are thankful for.

PSHE – Valuing difference

Pupils will be recognising, valuing and celebrating difference. They will be developing respect and accepting others as well as learning about bullying and getting help.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Science – The scientists will explore different materials and their uses by identifying their properties.

Topic- The historians will identify and name a variety of dinosaurs that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will learn about different sources of information and how we know dinosaurs existed. As well as theories of extinction.

Computing-Pictograms & Researching

The children will collect and present data in a pictogram using Purple Mash. They will also learn how to search effectively on the internet.





Physical Development Tuesday – Dance
