English

Non-fiction writing- Recounts

The authors will write recounts and diary entries inspired by the Diary of a Wombat and The Great Fire.

They will be proof reading and editing their writing for spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Fiction- Modern Fiction- Ed Vere Stories

The authors will explore stories by Ed Vere including Max the Brave. They will sequence their ideas and form longer sentences by using conjunctions, speech and description.

Poetry- Poems about families

They will delve into the world of poetry and enjoy rhyme, repetition and language choices through Poems about families.

History

The historians will use a range of information sources to find out about the past. They will ask and answer questions about historic events and sequence them on a timeline with other key times in history that they have learnt this year. The children will then use their knowledge to communicate the information in a variety of ways. They will explore the what? why? when? who? how? They will learn about the key people and events during the fire. They will understand the impact of the fire on today.

Computing

They will look at the use of technology outside the classroom and creating pictures using Purple Mash.

Science

The scientists will be learning about 98planting, animals, caring for the planet and spring.

Year 1

The mathematicians will consolidate their understanding of place value with numbers up to 50 as well as addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers. They will explore measures through length, height, mass and volume.

Maths

Year 2

The mathematicians will be learning all about money. They will be recognising coins and notes. They will identify the total amount and find the change, including 2 step problems. They will also be learning about multiplication and division

They will explore measures through length and height, as well as mass, capacity and temperature.

Art

The artists will look at the buildings from 1666. They will use charcoal to create St Paul's Cathedral. They will also be making and evaluating bread.

Music

The musicians explore Imagination through listening to songs from films like Mary Poppins and Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. They will also explore pulse, rhythm and pitch through Latin music in Round and Round.





R.E

The children will learn: Why is Easter important to Christians?

PSHE

The citizens will explore how to keep themselves safe including online, sleep and medicines. They will also explore taking care of themselves, money and their environment.

Physical Education
