Homework will continue with one piece a week which will be handed in on a Wednesday and sent out on a Friday. Well done to our many pumpkin competition winners.



Information texts- The children will learn the difference between fiction and non fiction. They will learn the different features of an information text. They will read a range of non fiction texts to understand how they are laid out. All of this will then be used for the children to write their own information page about dinosaurs.

Poetry- The children will read, perform and write poetry using their senses.

SPaG- The children will continue to learn, revise and expand their phonic knowledge with weekly spellings. They will consolidate and apply their knowledge of punctuation in HIGH 5 sentences. They will identify verbs, nouns and widen/secure their knowledge of question and exclamation marks.

Knowledge and Understanding History



The historians will identify and name a variety of dinosaurs that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will learn about different sources of information and how we know dinosaurs existed.

Computing-Pictograms & Researching




The children will collect and present data in a pictogram using Purple Mash. They will also learn how to search effectively on the internet.

Science- Amazing Me!


The scientists will learn all about the parts of the body, senses and how humans grow. They will learn about the importance of exercise and a balanced diet.
